

RNZB Schools Performance Policy 2022

Each year, we invite teachers and students to experience live ballet by attending a Royal New Zealand Ballet performance, where they can delight in one of our main stage productions or one of our specially tailored school matinées.

Attending a Ballet With Your School Group

In addition to matinées just for schools in selected venues, the RNZB offers discounted tickets for school groups on a limited basis for each of our productions to encourage you and your students to experience the thrill of live dance.

Discounted tickets for school groups are available for the following centres: Auckland, Christchurch, Dunedin, Invercargill, Napier, Palmerston North and Wellington.

Ticket Prices*:

\$15 School Children/Teachers (ratio 9:1)

\$20 Additional Adults (maximum of 5)

*A service fee of \$6 will apply to each transaction at the time of booking

You will need 1 teacher for every 9 students, with a maximum of an additional 5 parents or teachers. Groups must be a minimum of 8 people.

Invoicing, Final Numbers & Payment

Once your reservation has been processed, we will send you an initial email confirmation. Please carefully review the confirmation for show title, date, time, and number of tickets in your reservation. 7 days prior to the performance an invoice for the total payable will be sent.

Your final ticket count for the reservation is due at least 7 days prior to your scheduled performance. Inside 7 days, changes to ticket numbers will not be possible.

Cancellations

While the RNZB will make every effort possible to present the programming as scheduled, occasionally performance cancellations will be out of our control, for example due to government COVID-19 restrictions.

Should a performance be unable to proceed, your school will be eligible for a full refund, transfer to a new date (if the performance is rescheduled) or for the full balance to be kept as a credit on account.

Otherwise, if your school are unable to attend for any reason, a fee of 20% of the booking total up to \$150 applies should the cancellation be received within 7 days of the scheduled performance. Due to the nature of the school matinees, last minute cancellations affect us greatly and leave us unable to resell booked seats.
