

Organisation and details

The Royal New Zealand Ballet (RNZB) invites applications for a new Trustee to join its Board. The vacancy relates to a three year term commencing 1 January 2020.

Steven Fyfe Chair of the RNZB retires at the expiry of his current term on 31 December 2019. RNZB needs to recruit a replacement Trustee and appoint a Chair. The Board will consider candidates for Chair from both within the current Board and new expressions of interest.

The RNZB is a company of dancers that brings world-class classical ballet to a wide range of New Zealanders. Performing to community and paid audiences, the RNZB aspires to be a compelling expression of New Zealand's creative spirit, delighting with the traditional and inspiring with the new. It has a turnover in excess of \$12 million and performed to over 100,000 people in 2018.

Particular skills/competencies sought

The role, together with other Trustees, are responsible for governance of all aspects of the business, setting the strategic direction for the organisation, reflecting the interests of stakeholders and ensuring the organisation contributes to our national identity and story.

We are seeking an enthusiastic and talented Trustee with strong governance credentials and experience.

All applicants must have a genuine interest in and passion for ballet and proven commercial acumen.

Diversity considerations

The Royal New Zealand ballet has a commitment to diversity and is seeking applicants that reflect New Zealand's cultural identity. Consideration will also be given to support our regional diversity, with a preference (but not a requirement) for a Wellington based Trustee on this occasion. Two of our Trustees are currently Wellington based with a preference to increase the number to three as Wellington is our home base.

Commitment required

Six meetings per year plus committee work. This totals approximately 120 hours annually for a Trustee and approximately 250 hours annually for the Chair.
